FORMULA

Each 100 mL contains:

Thiamine Hydrochloride 1000 mg

Riboflavin 5-phosphate 200 mg

Pyridoxine hydrochloride 200 mg

Cyanocobalamin (B-12) 10 mg

Panthenol 1333 mg

Niacinamide 2500 mg

Lidocaine Hydrochloride 250 mg

Benzyl Alcohol 1000 mg

Vehicle c.b.p. 100 ml

PRESENTATIONS

Bottles with 100 ml.

USE

Cattle, horses, sheep, goats, pigs, dogs and cats.

DESCRIPTION

Combination of B vitamins, indicated for the prevention and treatment of Hypovitaminosis, anemic states and stages of convalescence in all species.

DOSE

Bovine and Equine: 5 to 10 mL

Sheep, Goats and Swine: 3 to 5 mL

Canines and Felines: 0.5 to 1 mL

INDICATIONS

It is indicated in vitamin deficiencies and periods of drought, since the lack of green pastures reduces the levels of vitamins obtained in the diet. Indicated in hypovitaminosis A, D and E. It is also indicated in animals with low milk, meat or wool production. Rickets, osteomalacia, anorexia, convalescence.

Coadjuvant in cases of infertility in females and males.

ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION

Administer by intramuscular, intravenous or subcutaneous injection.

WARNINGS

Shake well before use.

Store in a cool place and protected from sunlight.
